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CMS FAQs Mediasite Script

Have you ever wondered where the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) are located?

First, go to the CMS Website at www.cms.hhs.gov and do one of two things. Click on the “Questions” link located in the top header bar or go to the specific topic and use the direct links from those pages.

If you access the FAQs using the “Questions” link you will come up with 1,933 questions and answers. In order to narrow the field, enter a phrase or word in the search field. Let us search for the Physician Quality Reporting Initiative (PQRI) by entering PQRI in the search field. This narrows the questions and answers to 142. You can review each question; select a different page to move to, and sort by date updated. I like to sort by the update date. To do so, click on the arrow pointed down in the “Date Updated” header to bring up the most recently updated question.

CMS identifies new questions with the word “New.” Review the new questions and the updated questions to get the most current information.

Click on the actual question to read the answer. If you would like to change the topic, enter a new search word or phrase.
